# **Pre-Op Instructions**

- Labs are to be done ~3 weeks prior to surgery (fasting labs).
- DO NOT TAKE NSAIDS/ANTI-INFLAMMATORY MEDICATIONS in the
  2 weeks prior to surgery (See NSAIDS list).
  - Herbal supplements and extra Vitamin E also stop taking.
  - Tylenol is ok to take or current pain medications.
- If you are on any BLOOD THINNING MEDICATION, contact your physician who takes care of this for you and ask for instructions on when to start and stop any blood thinners (Plavix, Clopidogrel, Wararin, Coumadin, Aggrenox, Dipyridamole, Ticlid, and Aspirin).
- IF YOU HAVE A CARDIOLOGIST OR ANY SPECIALTY DOCTOR, you will need to call them for CLEARANCE as early as possible before surgery. This may mean you need to schedule an appointment with them to get clearance.
- Bring collar or back brace with you on the day of surgery, if given one.
